Treasurer's Report - Rachel Enloe

We have approximately \$11,000 in our IWLN account. This money includes memberships for 2026, Ringers money, some outside invitational money, and Chits money from October to December 2025.

Correction 4Feb2026 - The reason we still have 2025 chit money (approximately \$1,000) still in IWLN league account, is due to year-end changes by Blue Star management. Going forward chits will be processed in a timely manner through the Ironwood Pro Shop.

Pairings/Games/Scoring - Eileen Moberg

Please make sure that you sign up each week for golf using Chelsea. If you need to use the add/cancel line to sign up after Saturday at noon each week, the pairings committee will do their best to add you to the group for golf that week. There have been some times in the past few weeks where we had the exact number of foursomes signed up through Chelsea. If this happens, we cannot just add one or two people for

golf that week. You are not guaranteed a spot to play by calling the add/cancel line if the numbers don't work well. If you have called the add/cancel line make sure that you check the pairings sheet posted on Tuesday on the IWLN Website for your name, prior to coming to golf on Wednesday that week. The pairings committee will do their best to include all who want to play golf each week. We do not add golfers that show up on Wednesday morning who have not signed up for golf that week. If you need to cancel golf, please make sure that you call the add/cancel line. You can cancel right up to one hour prior to when we start golf on Wednesdays. Judy Hedding asked about scoring and utilizing "pops" each week. Eileen noted it depends on the game we are playing that week if "pops" are used in final scores. They are included because we do use the "net double bogey" pick-up rule every week.

Deb Burns noted that she is working on getting local businesses to advertise and sponsor a hole during our invitational. If you can help with this part of the fundraising, please contact Deb Burns. We are also having two separate raffles for the invitational. Sally Dixon is heading up both raffles. She will need some volunteers to assist her. One raffle (50-25-25) will be visiting other golf groups and events throughout Oakwood and Ironwood to sell raffle tickets in the upcoming weeks. The raffle money will then be distributed by calling the two winners. The other raffle will be on the day of our invitational with the drawing(s) during the luncheon that day after golf. This raffle will be for the baskets that are being made by IWLN members and also a 50-25-25 raffle of the money collected.
