

Ringers

The Ironwood Lady Niners' Ringers Tournament results in a player's **ultimate round** which is the best the player shot on each hole over the duration of the tournament. The score for each hole never increases...it either remains the same or decreases each round.

Participating players submit League scorecards as usual and the Ringers' Chair posts and maintains the Ringer scores.

The tournament duration is January to December, except for summer play and other games where chits are not paid. Only Ironwood Lady Niners League scores where the golfer uses her own ball for an entire nine-hole game will be used in the calculation of the ringer score, also called a "**ringer round**".

Participants must have a minimum of two postable scores on either the front or back nine to establish a score. Prize money for multiple places will be awarded for front-nine and back-nine. Ringers scores in each flight and monies will be presented at the Spring General Meeting the following year. Prize money will be determined by the number of players who participate in the Ringers Tournament.

Members who want to participate in the Ironwood Ladies Niners Ringers Tournament must submit \$6.00 (either check or cash) in an envelope clearly marked "Ringers" and showing your First and Last Name into the Ironwood Lady Niners mailbox no later than January 31.
